Cape Town's Big 6



1-Table Mountain Cableway
The aerial cable car has a slow-revolving carriage, so you get panoramic views all the way up and down. And if you're an SA citizen, you ride for free on your birthday; just bring your ID. Tickets for the cable car are available at the ticket office near the lower cable station, and online at: tablemountaintickets.co.za



2-Victoria & Alfred Waterfront
The V&A Waterfront has the oldest working harbour in the southern hemisphere, but also embraces hotels, restaurants, alfresco cafes, pubs and a brewery, a shopping mall, arts and crafts outlets, a farmer's market, a fish market, and many heritage buildings. It's a place where people come to shop, eat, live, work and play, or simply to watch the passing parade, and the seals. Visit: waterfront.co.za



3-Robben Island Museum
Your trip to Robben Island starts at the Nelson Mandela Gateway in the V&A Waterfront, where you board a ferry to the island, 12km offshore. On the island, a tour bus takes you to historic sites, such as the kramat, the leper graveyard, the quarry where political prisoners laboured, and finally, Mandela's former prison cell. 4-Kirstenbosch Garden
Kirstenbosch, on the eastern slopes of Table Mountain, is, arguably, the greatest botanical garden in the world. It has 7000 different plant species, 450 tree species, a world-class cycad collection, and fauna aplenty. The Boomslang, a wooden walkway at treetop level, offers breathtaking views. Entry fees apply, but the guided walking tours are free. Entry on Tuesdays is free for SA seniors with ID. Tel: 021 799 8783. sanbi.org/gardens/kirstenbosch



5-Groot Constantia
This wine estate has been crafting legendary wines since 1685. Their Grand Constantia is world-renowned, and was Napoleon's favourite dessert wine. Today, the estate has activities for everyone. Over-eighteens can sample signature wines and tour the cellars, then relax while dining and socialising. Families can picnic, with a playground for little ones; plus a variety of walking trails. 6-Cape Point
Cape Point is a rocky promontory at the southernmost tip of the peninsula. According to folklore, it is the meeting place of the Atlantic and Indian oceans. Hop on the funicular that takes you to the top of the cliff, and marvel at the magnificent views. And look out for the ill-fated phantom ship, the Flying Dutchman. Light meals available at the cafe. 7-Big 5 Safari
An authentic wildlife safari only 2 hours from Cape Town. Travel in a luxury air-conditioned vehicle. On arrival, enjoy welcome drinks, followed by a tasty buffet lunch. Then depart on your 2-hour game drive. On a good day, you might see all five: lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo. Later, relax by the pool and admire the Karoo, before returning to Cape Town.



8-Tour of the Winelands
The Cape Winelands embraces three historically famous towns: Paarl, Franschoek and Stellenbosch, all known for fine wines and local cuisine. Spend a day exploring all three in a luxury air-conditioned vehicle, with a qualified and informative guide, while tasting award-winning wines. The tour includes a delicious lunch and 3 wine tastings with pairings.



9-Cape Town City Tour
The Mother City calls, so take a day to explore: iconic Table Mountain with 360° views of the Peninsula; the Slave Lodge Museum; tea and scones at the Mount Nelson. Watch a diamond cutter ply his craft while you sip on a glass of sparkling wine. Then treat your tastebuds to a traditional African meal in the V&A Waterfront at one of our most awarded restaurants.

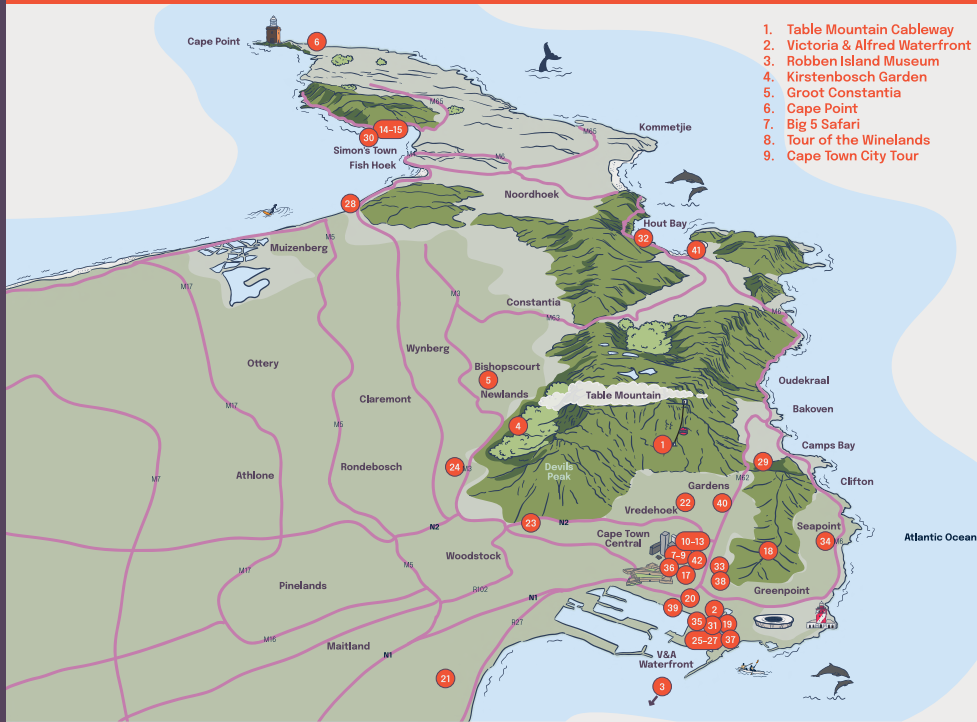
